

### Key questions and main issues addressed

#### Context:

Strong pressure on/destruction of forests through high firewood usage

### Possible solution:

Alternatives to firewood e.g. liquid and gaseous fuel exist:

- LPG
- Biogas
- Bio-ethanol
- Kerosene → clean?

but which alternatives are concretely possible for clean and sustainable cooking? Availability? Accessibility and means to support the production? Relevant equipment and their accessibility?



## Challenges meet solution

Challenges	Possible solutions
Accessibility & supply chain of the different alternatives	<ul> <li>Deeply analyze the supply chain of each fuel source incl. country specifics (available resources) and rural vs. urban areas</li> <li>Mix of fuel sources adapted to local situation to be developed &amp; updated vs. unique solution</li> <li>Adapt strategy &amp; support to the supply chain of each fuel source incl. awareness raising &amp; facilitated access to users</li> </ul>
Efforts focusing on improved cook stoves using biomass vs. alternative liquid & gaseous fuels	<ul> <li>Increased discussions on the topic at ECOWAS level and with ECREEE's support</li> </ul>

# Challenges meet solution per fuel source

Type	Challenges	Possible solutions/ Good practices
LPG	<ul> <li>Availability of LPG</li> <li>Sales price to consumer</li> <li>Acquisition of equipment</li> <li>Multiplication of PoS/distribution channels</li> </ul>	
Biogas	<ul> <li>Critical mass of biomass/waste needed to create biogas</li> </ul>	
Bio- Ethanol	<ul> <li>Availability of bio-ethanol on the market</li> <li>Equipment adapted to bio-ethanol</li> <li>Higher price</li> </ul>	R&D needed

### RECOMMENDATIONS

Regional	National
<ul> <li>Focus on fuels:</li> <li>Common: LPG &amp; biogas</li> <li>Case by case: other fuel alternatives</li> <li>incl. sharing of best practices and lessons learned; national &amp; regional targets</li> </ul>	Diagnostic study on each source per country and recommendations on needs related to liquid and gaseous fuels in terms of:  - Awareness raising - Capacity building - Equipment - Access to finance
Development of regional R&D in all new alternatives for local vs. imported solutions with support/coordination of ECREEE, incl. possible partnerships	Development and implementation of national relevant mix of liquid and gaseous fuels
Promotion of alternatives & adapted equipment with concrete supply chain over the region/country mix	
Harmonization of policies, taxes & subsidies equally across the fuel sources and usage (domestic vs. industrial)
